Identified needs for immediate response

Food

Household NFIs

Temporary Shelter and house repairs

WASH Supplies and Hygiene Promotion

Vector controls

School re-open and temporary learning centers
Road access
Rehabilitation Health post services

Recommendation:

Identified needs should be addressed sooner

Detailed assessment should be initiated as soon as possible in coordination with DDRC

GOs/ Humanitarian partners/NGOs/INGOs/ and local organizations should be avoided the duplication

Responsibilities should be prioritized based on findings
