Vacancy Announcement for Consultant

FHI 360, an international non-government organization (NGO), requests applications from qualified individuals to work as a short-term consultant to prepare Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) on bacteriological analysis for environmental samples in coordination with the Department of Environment (DoE) under The Fleming Fund Country Grant for Nepal (FFCGN) supported by UK Department of Health and Social Care through Mott MacDonald.

Key Responsibilities

The major tasks will include:

- Meeting with SOP preparation technical team at DoE.
- Draft the SOP and receive feedback from the technical team and experts. There will be a series of core group meetings during this process.
- Share in the wider group with experts and incorporate the suggestions/feedback received.
- Share the revised SOP in the finalization workshop and revise as per the suggestions received.
- Finalize the SOP and share the final draft as required and suggested by the technical team.

Qualifications

- Master's in microbiology with specialization in environment microbiology.
- Work experience/exposure in the processing of environment samples for bacteriological analysis (sampling, culture, isolation, identification, and antimicrobial susceptibility testing).
- Past work experience on guidelines/ protocols development
- Ability to write clearly and concisely in both languages (Nepal and English)
- Sound in computer applications such as MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint
