Vacancy Announcement

FHI 360, an international non-governmental organization (NGO), requests applications from qualified individuals to work as ‘Consultant – key population (KP) services’ to assess the current HIV treatment, prevention, care and support services implemented by Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) Nepal for men who have sex with men (MSM), male sex workers (MSWs) and transgender people in Nepal.

Consultant

This position will be responsible to assess the current gaps and needs on innovative approaches implemented by EpiC Nepal such as index testing, pre-exposure prophylaxis, HIV treatment and viral load services among KPs and priority populations in Nepal.

The position will work closely with the implementing partner agencies (IPs) in coordination with EpiC Nepal team at country office. S/he will also coordinate with local IPs for required support.

Qualification

- SEE/SLC pass, preferably 10+2 or intermediate level
- Good report writing skill/experience in English
- Previous experience working in HIV-related work with KPs
- Willing and ability to travel in the districts
