

ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCY

Position: Project Manager – Disability Inclusion -1 (Nawalparasi West, Bardaghat)

The main purpose of this position is to ensure successful implementation of Disability Inclusive Development (DID) Project and contribute to the UMN's cluster strategy through effective capacity-building, relationship-building, project management, and providing technical expertise.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Master's degree in Disability Inclusion or Social Science/Rural Development or equivalent with a minimum of three years' experience Or, a Bachelor's degree in Disability Inclusion or Social Science/Rural Development or equivalent with a minimum of five years' experience in integrated project management with particular focus on disability inclusion and rehabilitation, system strengthening, public advocacy and community empowerment.
- Excellent knowledge and understanding of current disability inclusion and rehabilitation issues, public advocacy, socio-economic development of Persons with Disabilities and their families, and protection issues in Nepal.
- Strong experience of project management including planning, budgeting, monitoring, reporting, and developing proposals.
- Experience in participatory bottom-up project designing, implementation, monitoring and evaluation.
- Familiar with up-to-date poverty reduction strategies, policies, and development practices in Nepal and outside.
- Experience in managing projects through local implementing partner organisation/s.
- Skilled in coordination and networking with local and district stakeholders.
- Experience of working in cross-cultural environment.
- Excellent communication skills both in English and Nepali. Both writing and speaking must be of an excellent standard.
