The consultant will support the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and the U.S. President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR)-supported EpiC Nepal in conducting qualitative interviews for psychosocial need assessment of key population (KP) and people living with HIV (PLHIV). The consultant will be required to conduct field visit outside Kathmandu.

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct in-depth interview of the beneficiaries following the guideline provided
- Conduct focus group discussions (FGD) of the selected service providers following the guideline provided
- Collect notes in the language of discussion, share the notes with the consultant responsible for conducting analysis

- Experience in conducting qualitative interviews
- Good communication skills required
- Training on research ethics
