 - It is not sealed properly (NA in case of email proposals)
 - There are any missing documents mentioned in the ToR
 - Information submitted by the company is found to be false
 - It is incomplete
- 2. A proposal should have <u>three (3) separate</u> envelops (NA in case of email proposals):
 - 1st for CVs of Proposed Consultants listed in Section B, Part 2 below.
 - 2nd for technical proposal
 - 3rd for financial proposal

Each of the above envelopes should be sealed, and properly labelled respectively as "supporting documents," "technical proposal" and "financial proposal." Each page of the proposal should be stamped and signed. All these three (3) envelopes then should be kept in **another envelop sealed with wax** (laha chhap).

- 4. Only shortlisted bidder/s will be contacted by Save the Children at each stage of the selection process.
- 5. Shortlisted bidder/s may be invited to deliver a 15minute presentation to the Procurement Committee on their technical proposal.

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Terms of Reference (ToR)

<u>Background on Save the Children:</u> Save the Children is the leading global independent organisation for children. Save the Children believes every child deserves a future. <u>Background information/context:</u> In leadership of National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority (NDRRMA)- Government of Nepal, the National Shelter, Housing and Settlement Forum (NSHSF) event is planned to organize on 25 -26 April 2023 in Kathmandu Nepal with the purpose of bringing together stakeholders from thematic sector of shelter, housing, and settlement, disaster preparedness, climate adaptive green solutions and on many more compelling ideas in Nepal to discuss and address issues related to DRRM. NSHSF is positioned with the theme of 'Sustainable and resilient shelter housing and settlements'.

This event is supported by stakeholders from three tiers of government, from federal to provincial and local along with a bunch of development partners, I/NGOs, several international participants, CSOs, academics, researchers and interested ones having common perspectives on DRRM, resilience and recovery. NHSRP has taken responsibility of Secretariat of NSHSF's Organizing Committee Organizations (Save the children, CRS, HfH, IFRC-NRCS, IOM, NSET, USAID, PIN) to conduct management, coordination and preparation tasks.

There are growing voices of making the event inclusive and accessible to all concerned ones particularly the participants whose first language is not Nepali. Similarly, use of the sign language during the program was prioritized in order to ensure inclusiveness and internalize the leaving no one behind approach.

Objective



- I. Simultaneous language translation (English to Nepali and vice-versa) during the program of NSHSF 2023.
- II. Sign Language Interpretation during the program of NSHSF 2023.

Location and official travel involved

Consultant will deliver the service within the Kathmandu Valley

Services the Supplier will provide

a. Language Translation/interpretation

- Consultant to conduct the language translation from Nepali to English and English to Nepali throughout the event (in main hall and in the second hall during parallel sessions
- Two language translators will be deployed in one hall. One each backup translator is required as per the consistency planning for translators' easiness ie. <u>four language translators are required.</u>
- Proper translation of the sharing conducted in both of the program halls.

b. Sign Language Interpretation

- Consultant to conduct the sign language interpretation particularly in the sessions organized in the main hall only (during opening session, main session, panel session, discussions and in the closing session.
- Two sign language interpreters are required.
- Proper language interpretation of the sharing conducted at the assigned program hall.

Experience and skill set required

a. Language Translation/interpretation

- At least three years of experience interpretation translation service
- Well versed in both Nepali and English languages
- Ability to remain objective and interpret communication between two or more parties.
- Previous experience working with Save the Children or other INGOs is desired.

b. Sign Language Interpretation

- At least three years of experience in sign language interpretation
- Well versed in both Nepali and English languages
- Ability to remain objective and interpret communication between two or more parties.
- Previous experience working with Save the Children or other INGOs is desired.

 - For Individuals (Nepali): Copies of citizenship certificate and PAN/VAT registration certificate;
 - For Individuals (Foreign Nationals): Copies of passport and a valid visa/permit to work in Nepal.

If an individual is a full-time staff member of another organization, a no objection/consent letter signed by the organization head must be submitted along with the proposal. This is not applicable for proposals sent through a firm.
