

FHI 360 Nepal Vacancy Announcement for Consultants

FHI 360, an international non-government organization (NGO), requests applications from qualified individuals to work for short-term consultancy service for the project under Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) Nepal with support from the United States Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). The consultants will be responsible for supporting in recording and reporting of the HIV/AIDS program-related indicators in One National HIV Information System (ONHIS)/Mero Data, which is a customized version of the District Health Information System (DHIS2).

Key Responsibilities

The major tasks will include:

- Enter, review, and correct the data in ONHIS/Mero Data generated from source recording and reporting formats for the period of June –September 2022.
- Carry out regular verification and data cleaning in the ONHIS/Mero Data.
- Report any error or debug determined in the newly introduced ONHIS.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in any discipline preferably in Public Health.
- Work experience/exposure in the field of HIV program
- Skill and experience in using DHIS2.
