

FHI 360 Nepal Vacancy Announcement for Consultant

FHI 360, an international non-government organization (NGO), requests applications from qualified individuals to work as a short-term consultant to conduct psychosocial counseling sessions under Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) Nepal with support from the United States President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) and United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

Key Responsibilities

The consultant will support EpiC Nepal in addressing psychosocial issues and challenges faced by the key population (KP), people living with HIV (PLHIV) and frontline workers through psychosocial counseling sessions. The counseling will be conducted virtually and/or in-person based on the situation.

The major tasks will include:

- Conduct psychosocial counseling sessions series for Implementing Partner (IP) staff, service providers, and selected beneficiaries
- Conduct group psychosocial sessions of the FHI 360 and staff of the national stakeholders
- Preparation of psychosocial counseling session package
- Evaluate the outcome of psychosocial counseling provided to KP and PLHIV

Qualifications

- Master's degree /Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Psychology
- Professional skills and knowledge on psychosocial counseling and experience in providing individual, family and group counseling to children, adolescents, and adult population. (Experience in working with vulnerable population preferred.)
