The Project Specialist is overall responsible to lead and oversight the Youth Employment and Entrepreneurship (YEED) project. The key role of this position is planning, budgeting, capacity building, documentation, reporting, quality assurance and partnership management. The Project Specialist will play a vital role in developing and facilitating private sector actor's engagement to achieve the specified outcomes of the project. The position holder will be the focal person for the smooth implementation of the project. S/he will responsible for representation and networking with donor, government (local, province and federal), likeminded organization and different department of Plan International Nepal.

This position will need to effectively coordinate with Finance department of regional office east and Country finance team along with relevant program team and other function is necessary

### 3. Project Officer for Youth Employment and Entrepreneurship (YEED)- 1 Position

Fixed-Term Employment until August 2025 based in Sindhuli under Regional Office-East (Dhanusa)

The Project Officer will be overall responsible for project and partnership management in district. S/he will provide technical support to implementing partner organization for the "Youth Employment and Entrepreneurship Development (YEED) Project". S/he will be based in partner office under Regional Office – East, Sindhuli district with frequent field visit in Dhanusha district. S/he will be responsible for ensuring effective implementation of project in Dhanusha and Sindhuli in coordination and collaboration with private sectors, government line agencies and other likeminded organization. The position holder will require to represent Plan International Nepal at local, provincial and federal level as required.
