Engaging with Business Development (BD) team, s/he will ensure meeting Plan and/or donor compliance and timely reporting. Furthermore, she/he will be responsible to manage overall field implementation of the project at the proposed district level. Project Coordinator will represent Plan in various forums in the respective sector/s; clusters at province, district; local government at rural/municipal level; other relevant stakeholders and likeminded organizations in province, districts and local government.
