The project will support to recover and rehabilitate WASH facilities and services, promote climate resilient WASH facilities, promote gender responsive menstrual hygiene management MHM services and make schools and communities resilient at the face of disaster. The proposed project is planned in three rural municipalities (Hima, Sinja and Kanakasundari) of Jumla district of Karnali province. The position holder is responsible to ensure the achievements of intended outcomes and impacts by strengthening Climate Resilient WASH governance and institutional framework through municipalities. Similarly, the Project Coordinator needs to support to review of engineering design of WASH interventions with quality assurance of implementation. The role is required to support local government for effective and efficient delivery of inclusive, gender friendly, resilient and sustainable WASH initiatives.
