#### **Terms of Reference (ToR)**

#### **Background on Save the Children**

# **Background information/context**

National Public Health Laboratory (NPHL) is the largest stand-alone reference public health laboratory in Nepal proving wide range of diagnostic laboratory services to public. It provides both general and specialized diagnostic services for both communicable and non-communicable diseases. It also serves as a national reference laboratory for several diseases including COVID-19, influenza, HIV, Hepatitis B and C infection, bacterial infections, Japanese Encephalitis, Dengue and many more.

NPHL has been conducting laboratory-based trainings on HIV and STI on relevant national guidelines. A participant manual was developed in 2014 to facilitate this training. However, since then there have been several changes in national guidelines including national HIV diagnostic algorithms for both adults and infants. Also, guidelines related to HIV viral load testing and CD4 testing have also been changed. There is a need for updating and revising the existing participant manual as well as training materials including PowerPoint presentations. NPHL intends to revise the existing manual to develop an integrated training package which includes a general and test specific modules (CD4, EID, Viral load) so that different levels of HIV and STI lab trainings can be conducted as per need.

Technical assistance from a local expert is required for supporting NPHL in the revision and



development of an integrated training package (modular participant manual and training materials: PowerPoint presentations) on HIV and STI laboratory trainings. The consultant requires to closely work with NPHL HIV team and other relevant experts to develop the manual.

#### **Objective**

To review, update and prepare integrated training Package for HIV laboratories in National HIV Program.

### **Location and official travel involved**

This activity may require very few local travels within Kathmandu valley but does not necessitate frequent travels.

#### Services local consultant will provide

The local consultant is responsible for the following activities.

- 1. Review existing national guiding documents and training materials related to HIV and STI laboratory diagnosis in Nepal
- 2. Organize and facilitate a workshop to review existing training materials related to HIV and STI diagnosis (including CD4, EID and viral load sample collection and testing)
- 3. Prepare common and specific training modules (including participant manual and training slides) based on the feedback received from the workshop
- 4. Organize and facilitate a workshop to finalize the revised training modules
- 5. Finalize the training modules based on the feedback from second workshop
- 6. Conduct meetings with NPHL and stakeholders for review and finalization the training modules

### **Experience and skill set required**

The individual consultant or the team member proposed by the supplier should have the following minimum competencies:

- 1. Should have master or higher degree in lab sciences.
- 2. At least 7 years of work experience in laboratory field
- 3. Experience in HIV related activities preferred
- 4. Should have Microsoft basic office package knowledge and skills
- 5. Good report writing and documentation skills in English
- 6. Previous experience in development of training materials preferred
- 7. Understanding of national HIV program would be an advantage
